Introduction of project “Young researchers – educate, discover, prove and apply in environmental sciences”

The main aim of the project is to enable short term visits of young researchers and give them the opportunity to exchange experience and knowledge with academic and research staff at the partner university. Young researchers will participate in common courses during their stay where they will be educated in the field of environmental sciences. The secondary goal is to strengthen collaboration between Masaryk University (MU) using infrastructure of the Research Centre for Toxic Compounds in the Environment and the Norwegian University of Life Sciences (NMBU) and to link the scientific teams of both institutions. The education of young researchers will be supported by organizing seminars involving invited guests (experts in the topic, colleagues from related disciplines, risk assessors etc.). The most important benefit is the opportunity for joint work of Czech and Norwegian young researchers and the enhancement of their chances of continued collaboration during their scientific careers.
